 Exam Paper A2 1 This is a 90 minute exam consisting of two sections, corresponding to the two outlined above: Section A is worth 60 marks and has three subsections corresponding to the three options in Human Geography, each in turn having two questions. You should choose one question from both of the options we have studied (i.e. Population and Ethnic Diversity). The questions will be a mix of recall, data response and case study, including at least one question requiring answers in extended prose. Section B is worth 30 marks. It has four structured questions, one each for the Global Issues on the Spec. Again, at least one question will require answers written in extended prose. 	 Exam Paper A2 2 This is a 150 minute examination of two sections: Section A is worth 60 marks and has three subsections corresponding to the three options in Physical Geography, each in turn having two questions. You should choose one question from both of the options we have studied (i.e. River/Coasts and the Dynamic Earth). The questions will be a mix of recall, data response and case study, including at least one question requiring answers in extended prose. Section C is the Decision Making Exercise and is worth 50 marks.
